Ideas for your DreamBox-Themed Family Math Night

DreamBox Night of Fun

- Print out DreamBox posters and hang them around your classroom (available in the Resources tab of your Insight Dashboard).
- At the beginning of the night, help your students' parents set up their Family Insight Dashboard using the computers in your classroom or computer lab.
- Once they've learned how to log-in to their Family Insight Dashboard, show your students' parents how to navigate the important reports, such as the Activity Feed. **Tip:** Recommend that parents use the "Play Lesson" functionality in their Insight Dashboard to facilitate discussions about what the student is learning.
- Send parents home with helpful resources to reinforce and empower learning with DreamBox at home, such as the 'Using DreamBox at Home' flyer or the 'Parent Letter' downloadable in your Insight Dashboard.

Station Rotation Model

Setting up a station rotation can be a great way to engage parents! Try to identify a few parent leaders in advance of your Family Math Night who can help facilitate each station.

- **Video Station:** Play the video explaining DreamBox Learning Math and "Why Kids Love DreamBox" (refer to videos listed on the next page).
- **Computer Station:** Have parents play DreamBox lessons to get familiar with our "think and do" learning experience:

- **Physical Manipulative Station:** Set out physical manipulatives with an assignment that you've given your students and have parents work through the problems.
